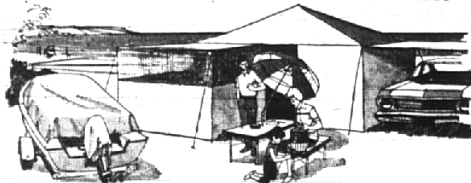

Abortion trial 3 face arrest

Mr. Justice Gray issued warrants for the arrest of three people who failed to appear for their trial on abortion charges in the County Court yesterday.

He also ordered the forfeiture of a total of \$4800 in sureties and bail.

The three who failed to appear to answer charges of performing illegal abortions are Stanley Charles Wyatt, 44, of Geelong Road, Footscray; Marion Josephine Rose, 21, and Gert Herman Rose, 46, both of Dunedin Street, Maddingstone.

Dr. William Fenton-Bowen, 65, of Toorak Road, Toorak, and Mrs. Elva Isabel Moran, 50, of Geelong

Road Footscray, were the only ones of the five accused to appear.

Judge Blair said it was "extraordinary" that one of the co-defendants, Fenton-Bowen, acted as surety for Marion Rose.

Wyatt forfeited \$1500 bail; Gert Herman Rose, \$500, and Marion Rose \$400.

Mrs. Mabel Robinson, acted as surety for Wyatt, forfeited \$1500. Guillaume Joseph Willems, surety for Gert Rose, forfeited \$500.

Judge Gray ordered Fenton-Bowen to forfeit \$400 for his surety on Marion Rose.

Counsel for Wyatt (Mr. M. Lincoln) told the court he understood his client would appear but he did not know where Wyatt was at present.

Judge Gray allowed a brief adjournment for inquiries to be made, then adjourned the trial to tomorrow.

Last night police said Wyatt, Gert Rose and Marion Rose had still not been found.

Six made QC

The State Executive Council yesterday appointed six Melbourne barristers as Queen's Counsel.

They include the Liberal member for East Yarra in the Legislative Council, Mr. Haddon Storey.

The other QCs are Mr. N. R. McPhee, Mr. N. M. O'Brien, Mr. J. A. Gobbo, Mr. R. H. Searby and Mr. D. Dawson.

Aborigines halt traffic in land rights protest



Darwin Aborigines squat in front of peak-hour traffic — for the second time within a month — as a protest against the Federal Government's refusal to give them rights to "tribal land".

Twenty-nine Aborigines blocked the morning traffic in Bagot Road for 15 minutes before police arrived and told them to move to the side of the street.

Traffic banked up for almost half a mile. Members of the Larrakia tribe are claiming an area known as Kulaluk which, they said, was of ceremonial significance and included a tribal burial ground.

A spokesman for the natives, Mr. Johnny Rejo, said: "We want Kulaluk. This is our land, Larrakia land, and the Larrakias have a right to it."

The Aborigines have sent a deputation to the Administrator and have written to the Minister for the Interior (Mr. Hunt) asking that the land be handed over to the Larrakias.

They are camped in tin shanties and tents on the disputed land.

Cutty Sak: court told of threat

BRISBANE. — A former prisoner claimed in the Supreme Court yesterday that while in Brisbane's Boggo Road gaol he had written a threatening letter dictated by Alexander Duncan Carstens.

The Crown has claimed in the Cutty Sak murder case, which went into its eighth day today, that the letter and a sketch showing three youths stranded on a desert island was sent to missing youths: Bruce Hugh Peters, 21, of Holland Park, and Kerry Clifford Rowan, 18, of Woody Point.

The Crown claims that Carstens told police the youths were on an old
