RACISM AGAIN AS DARWIN BLACKS COUNT CYCLONE COST

DARWIN: The latest issue of BUNJI, the newssheet of the Larrakia people appeared here last week, with continuing evidence of discrimination.

Larrakia leader Fred Fogarty was refused permission to attend the Northern Land Council meeting on March 25 and 26, to represent the Larrakia, because a white official, Mr. Wilders, said he was not an Aborigine.

Fred recently went to Brisbane where he found "plenty of evidence to prove he was Aborigine in blood and soul."

Larrakias have prevented the Darwin adminstration dumping the ruins of the city onto most of their land claim.

All buildings erected on the land claim at Kulaluk were destroyed, while repairs to the Gwalwa Daraniki truck cost \$540.

Ironically, **Bunji** comments, "now the land is not worth any money, maybe the Larrakias will be left alone." The claim was in the "danger cyclone surge area".
