Naidong's daughter, Blanche Tucker, told the anthropologist, Sandy Toussaint, 'I have some country at Mulga Downs through my grandfather but it is not really my place to talk about it.'<sup>1</sup> Blanche may have been referring to the father of Whitehead who was her paternal grandfather but it is more likely in the context that she was referring to the connection of Naidong's father, Jacob Tucker, to country 'at Mulga Downs.'
