

Below are listed some Youtube videos of Aboriginal ceremonies conducted on the Kulaluk lease in Darwin and general scenes of land usage on the lease between 1971-2014.

Just as Christian, Muslim, Buddhist and other religions have land set aside in towns for religious practices, for their mental and spiritual health Aboriginal people in Darwin need bushland where ceremonies and other gatherings can be held in a culturally appropriate manner. In these videos, Larrakia and Arnhem Land Aboriginal people are filmed conducting “rites of passage” ceremonies at various sites on the Kulaluk lease. Similarly, before the land was excised from the Bagot Aboriginal Reserve, all manner of ceremonies were held, from initiations to burials, including Kunupipi and Pukamani ceremonies.
