


## 5.30pm Friday 29th July @ Burnett House

Tibby Quall will introduce the Batcho Family of the Dangalaba Kulumbiringin Tribe of Darwin and launch an accompanying exhibition celebrating Batcho ancestral connections, genealogy and history of land claims in Darwin and the Cox Peninsula.
