

From affidavit of Horace Parker:

9. I got my own culture right here on Youngaleena from the old people. I know the law inside out, lots of people from all over come here for my law as far away as La Grange, Meekatharra, Mullewa and other places.

13. I speak Banyjima, and Mirralarnpha Banyjima (top end) Nyiyaparli, Nyamal, Ngarla (inland).

14. I married a Yindjiparndi woman [Biddy] we had two sons. My second wife was a Nyiyaparli woman and we had 14 children, we lost three children 2 girls and one boy.

16. I have a very strict Aboriginal law given to me by my grandparents and I still got it.
